Arriving at Hangzhou Xiaoshan International Airport

By taxi (preferred)

Duration: 50 minutes

Cost: around 200 RMB

By bus

You can take Airport Bus to Hangzhou East Railway Station and then take city bus No.74 or No.93 for the daytime or No.227 for the night to get to Zi-jin-gang Campus.

Duration: 2 hours

Cost: less than 30 RMB

By metro

As you reach Hangzhou East Railway Station, you can take metro to Zi-jin-gang Campus at Line 2 and exit at Xia Long Wei(虾龙圩) or San Ba(三坝) Station, and then walk for 15 minutes.

Duration: 2 hours

Cost: less than 30 RMB

Arriving at Shanghai Pudong International Airport or Shanghai Hongqiao Airport

You can take metro or taxi from Pudong International airport to Shanghai Hongqiao Railway Station, and then take railway to Hangzhou:

Shanghai Hongqiao Railway Station-Hangzhou East Railway Station (preferred) / Hangzhou Railway Station

By high-speed train (G-series train)

Duration: 50 minutes

Cost: 73 RMB for second-class seat

By bullet train (D-series train)

Duration: 1 hour

Cost: 56 RMB for second-class seat

You'll need to complete the process before you begin your study. Please remember to take passport and cash with you and turn to student buddy for help.

(1) Accommodation

International students who need to live in campus will be allocated by the university according to their majors, campuses where they will take their lectures. Necessities include beddings, desk and storage locker, air-conditioning, hot water supply, campus wired and wireless network.

International students who live off campus must be approved by the International College after submitting an application form for off-campus accommodation. After signing contract with the owner/agent and within 24 hours' of moving in, you need to go to the local police station in the dwelling area for a residence registration. Moreover, please have your new address recorded at International College.

It is advised to be discreet when signing contract with real estate agent or private owner to avoid future dispute. For inquiries please ask staff from International College for help.

International students who live off-campus but fail to register at the local police station will face large fines.

(3) Get Student Card

Add: Administrative Hall, Nano Building, East Zone, Zijingang Campus, ZJU

Materials: passport, cash, copy of Admission Notice

(4) Get Internet Access

Add: Administrative Hall, Nano Building, East Zone, Zijingang Campus, ZJU

Materials: student card, photocopy of passport and cash

*After your account is activated, you can log in wireless Internet at ZJU with your account. SOM also provides wireless Internet service inside SOM Building. You can easily log into "som" with password "somsomsom" while you are inside the building.

(5) Registration at SOM

Add: Room 402B, School of Management Building, East Zone, Zi-jin-gang Campus, ZJU

Materials: 1 2-inch bear-headed photos, original and copy of passport

(6) Course selection

Add: Room 307, School of Management Building, East Zone, Zi-jin-gang Campus, ZJU

(7) Attend the orientation

Orientation will be held at the beginning of each semester. The aim is to help exchange students get familiar with life here at ZJU.

(8) Get a new phone card

The major mobile service companies are China Mobile and China Unicom. Please bring your

passport with you when purchasing a pre-paid plan (SIM card) in-store. You can select a range of pre-payment plans for calls and data.

(9) Open a bank account

Cards issued by many international finance systems can be used in major shops and restaurants and on ATMs in China. The most widely acceptable ones are VISA and MasterCard.

In recent years Alipay and WeChat wallet has been increasingly popular. You can use mobile payment in most shops and restaurants by a simple QR scanning.

Many bank outlets in Hangzhou provide foreign currency exchange service. You can change your money into RMB conveniently. To open a bank account, please bring your passport and prepare 10-40 RMB in advance for deposit. The nearest branches are:





(1) Climate and Weather

The climate of Hangzhou is humid subtropical with four distinctive seasons, characterized by long, hot, humid summer and chilly, cloudy and dry winter (with occasional snow). The annual temperature is 16.2°C and average annual rainfall is about 1500 mm. The city is affected by the plum rains of the Asian monsoon in late June and heavy rain, potential typhoon in July and August. January is the coldest month of the year while July and August are the hottest.

(2) National Holidays and Festivals

Please pay attention to related notice since the exact dates of national holidays and festivals vary each year according to the lunar calendar. During those days, you can invite your family for a visit to China as a good way to ease homesick.

(3) Transport

Besides air, metro, bus and taxi, there are other means of transport for you to explore the city.

Campus Shuttle Bus

ZJU provides shuttle buses between different campuses. Different shuttles have different routes. Please make sure you are taking the correct one when you are traveling across campus.

City Bus

Hangzhou has a comprehensive city bus system. Bus tickets range from 1-5 RMB. The price is displayed on the coin slot when you step on.

Travel Buses: Buses numbers start with “Y”, designated for travel routes and will take you to tourist destinations.

Night Buses: Number 201-251, run from 21:30 pm to 5:30 am.

BRT (Bus Rapid Transit): Bus numbers start with B, such as B2. These buses stop at BRT station only.

Taxi

The starting price for taxi is 11 RMB/3km. The fare is 2.5 RMB between 3-10km and 3.75R RMB after 10 km. Taxi also charge 2.5 RMB for every 4 minutes when the car is stopped.

Shared Bicycle

It's always a nice alternative to rent a bicycle with an app for a spin on nice weather. The commonly seen brands are Mobike, Hello bike and ofo. You can discern these bikes easily everywhere. The fare is 0.5 RMB/30mins or 1 RMB / 30mins and requires a fundable deposit of 99-299 RMB.



Ferry

Close to Qiantang River, Hangzhou enjoys a developed water transport system. Wulinmen (武林门) Ferry Dock is the departure terminal for canal transport. You can take ferry to enjoy river sight in Hangzhou.

(4) Food and Dining

Recognized as one of the eight major schools of cuisine in China, Hangzhou food is characterized by its light flavors, enjoyable presentation and delicate cooking methods.

There are more than 20 on-campus dining halls/cafeterias located in different campuses offering a wide range of cuisines, including 3 international students dining halls. The daily expenses on meals are from 15 to 40 RMB.

You can find several on-campus grocery stores/convenient stores on campus around the residential area. And the nearest supermarket are:

(7) Library

ZJU Library consists of five branch libraries in separate campuses. In addition to its large collections, ZJU Library subscribes 524 online databases which offer vast digital resources.

You can borrow books with your student card and 200 RMB deposit, and return them within 40 days or renew them for another 40 days. For each book, there is only one chance for renewal. If you overdue books, you'll have to pay a fine of 0.05 RMB per book per day. And you can return books in any ZJU Libraries regardless of which ZJU Library you borrow the books from.


